PROPER USE, PROPER STORAGE, PROPER DISPOSAL

MyOldMeds.com highlights the importance of proper use, storage, and, when necessary, disposal of unwanted, unused, or expired medicines.



Follow the **instructions exactly as provided**including labeling information and Medication Guides
accompanying the medicine.
If you have any questions, ask your healthcare providers.



In particular, follow any **storage** instructions as provided on the medicine label and on the patient information accompanying the medicine.



Keep the medicine in a **secure** location, either in a medicine cabinet or safely away from people or pets that might come in contact with it.



When medicine is unwanted, unused, or expired, **dispose** of it immediately, properly, and according to local regulations. Remove or destroy all identifying personal information on the medication labels or packaging to protect your privacy.







pharmacies, healthcare facilities, law enforcement agencies, and government offices. The information is updated twice a year and delivers address, phone, and website details for each site along with hours of operation and the services offered including drop-off kiosks, mail back options, and free in-home disposal kits. MyOldMeds.com is hosted by the Pharmaceutical Product Stewardship Work Group (PPSWG), a nonprofit association funded by pharmaceutical producers.

Step 2: Remove any personal information from the medication's labels and packaging.

Once you've identified your disposal option, remove and destroy any labels or packaging containing personal information. Even though your medication will never be accessible to the public, we still recommend removing any personal information from the label before disposal.

Step 3: Dispose of your unwanted medicine, and spread the word!

Before you go, confirm the hours of operation at your disposal site. While the information provided on MyOldMeds.com is checked regularly for accuracy, it's still best to call to confirm before your visit. Then, simply drop your medicine in a kiosk or use the mail back option and you're done.

Encourage others to consider using MyOldMeds.com to dispose of their unwanted medicine, too. Not only will you help them clear the clutter from their medicine cabinets, but you'll pay a part in keeping our community safer and healthier.
